Complete phasing out of the manual application procedures for I/E licences for unregistered pharmaceutical products with effect from 1 July 2016

With effect from 1 July 2016, only online applications via the electronic licencing system, namely Pharmaceuticals Licence Application and Movement Monitoring System ("PLAMMS") will be accepted regarding applications for import/export (I/E) licences for unregistered pharmaceutical products for re-export purpose. <u>After 1 July 2016, manual submission of the relevant applications</u> will no longer be accepted at the counter of Drug Office.

The above changes in import/export licensing procedures have been notified to all relevant importers/exporters via letters issued on 26 June 2015, 21 Dec 2015 and 29 March 2016.
