Reminder: Phase out of Manual Application

for Import/Export Licences of Unregistered Pharmaceutical Products

Further to the letter issued to your company on 26 June 2015, you are kindly reminded that with effect from 1 July 2016, Drug Office ("DO") will only accept online applications for I/E licences for unregistered pharmaceutical products through our electronic licencing system, namely Pharmaceuticals Licence Application and Movement Monitoring System ("PLAMMS").

Since the implementation of PLAMMS, registered users can apply the I/E licences online and print the approved licences with their own computers in their work place with the advantages of reducing processing time and gaining logistic conveniences. Therefore, we sincerely urge your company to be registered user and start to enlist the products you intend to import and export, so that you can benefit from the PLAMMS as soon as possible.

We wish to emphasize that after 1 July 2016, manual submission of I/E licence applications for unregistered pharmaceutical products will no longer be accepted and the corresponding import/export of unregistered pharmaceutical product will be interrupted if you have not used PLAMMS by then.

To facilitate your understanding of PLAMMS, regular workshop sessions are conducted by DO twice a week. You can call 2319 8672 for registration for the workshop or any enquiries regarding PLAMMS. Please also visit the website of DO at www.drugoffice.gov.hk for more detailed information of PLAMMS.
