

## 1. Introduction

The Electronic Clinical Trial System (e-CTS) is a web-based internet and intranet system provided for all applicants and holders of Certificate for Clinical Trial/Medicinal Test.

The scope of the system covers new applications, amendments and subsequent submissions for clinical trial/medicinal test. The system is launched on 30 June 2022. Manual submission of application for Certificate for Clinical Trial / Medicinal Test is no longer accepted upon system launch.

### **Scope of e-CTS**

e-CTS serves the following objectives:

- To allow CTC applicants and CTC holders to submit new applications, amendments and/or subsequent submissions (e.g. progress reports and final reports) online via electronic system.
- To allow CTC applicants to track the status of application progress in the system.
- To provide an efficient communication channel between CTC applicants and DHDO.
- To allow CTC applicants to make on-line payments.
- Once application is approved and payment is completed, to allow CTC applicants to download and print valid CTC at user site.
