

Notes for use

- Not to be swallowed.
- Do not eat, drink or rinse your mouth immediately after using the mouthwash.

Possible side effects

Some mouthwashes can alter your taste or stain your teeth.

Consult your doctor immediately if you experience any allergic reactions such as skin rash, swelling of the face or hands and breathing difficulty.

Storage

Store the medications in a cool, dry place and away from direct heat and light. Generally, there is no need to store in the refrigerator unless stated on drug labels.

Store the medications out of reach of children to avoid accidental ingestion.

How to use Medicinal mouthwash

1 Rinse your mouth with water.



3 Hold the mouthwash in your mouth and swish it around inside.



4 Spit out the mouthwash.



2 Measure out the right dose of mouthwash.



! Refer to the individual drug labels for their respective dilution methods. For thymol gargle, dilute 1 part of mouthwash with 3 parts of water.

! The recommended duration varies among different preparations.
