

Canada: Unauthorized products may pose serious health risks - Update

Health Canada is advising Canadians about unauthorized health products that may pose serious health risks. The table below is updated when Health Canada finds unauthorized health products that are promoted for sexual enhancement, weight loss, as a workout aid, or as “poppers”, and that are labelled to contain or have been tested and found to contain dangerous ingredients.

The unauthorized products added are:

Stimu-Up (Thermax Effect) Weight loss	Labelled to contain yohimbine	
Thyrolan (Metabolic Optimizer) Weight loss	Labelled to contain yohimbine	

Consumers are advised to stop using these products and consult with their health care professional if they have used these products and have health concerns.
