

Canada: Unauthorized products may pose serious health risks: Update

Health Canada is advising Canadians about unauthorized health products that may pose serious health risks. The table below is updated when Health Canada finds unauthorized health products that are promoted for sexual enhancement, weight loss, as a workout aid, or as “poppers”, and that are labelled to contain or have been tested and found to contain dangerous ingredients.

The unauthorized products added are:

Product & Promoted Use	Hazard Identified	Company
Rhino Super Long Lasting 200k Sexual enhancement	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain tadalafil	Maple Convenience 3830 Bloor St. West Etobicoke, ON
Stiff Rox Sexual enhancement	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain sildenafil and tadalafil	
Black Panther #1 Sexual enhancement	Labelled to contain yohimbe	
Rhino 7 Platinum 5000 Sexual enhancement	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain sildenafil and yohimbe	

Consumers are advised to stop using these products and consult with their health care professional if they have used these products and have health concerns.
