

Canada: Unauthorized sexual enhancement products may pose serious health risks: Update

Health Canada is advising about unauthorized sexual enhancement products that may pose serious health risks. The products are labelled to contain or have been tested and found to contain dangerous ingredients. Health Canada updates the table below when it finds unauthorized health products for sexual enhancement.

The unauthorized products added are:

Product	Hazard Identified	Company
Rhino 7 Platinum 5000	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain sildenafil and yohimbe	JC Foodlane 270 Wellington St. W. #7-8 Toronto, ON M5V 3P5
Ginseng Red 2000	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain sildenafil	
XXL Ant 3000	Labelled to contain yohimbe	
Black Panther	Labelled to contain yohimbe	
Rush Hour 72	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain sildenafil and tadalafil	
Stiff Rock	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain sildenafil and tadalafil	

Consumers are advised to stop using these products and consult their health care professional if they have used these products and have health concerns.
