

Canada: Unauthorized sexual enhancement products may pose serious health risks

Health Canada is advising about unauthorized sexual enhancement products that may pose serious health risks. The products are labelled to contain or have been tested and found to contain dangerous ingredients. Health Canada updates the table below when it finds unauthorized health products for sexual enhancement.

The unauthorized products are:

Black Panther #1	Labelled to contain yohimbe	
Rhino 69 Platinum 35000	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain tadalafil	
Rhino 69 Platinum 700K	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain sildenafil	
Spanish Fly	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain tadalafil	
White Panther	Labelled to contain yohimbe
