

## Canada: Unauthorized sexual enhancement products may pose serious health risks: Update

Health Canada is advising about unauthorized sexual enhancement products that may pose serious health risks. The products are labelled to contain or have been tested and found to contain dangerous ingredients. Health Canada updates the table below when it finds unauthorized health products for sexual enhancement.

The unauthorized product added is:
