

Canada: Unauthorized sexual enhancement products may pose serious health risks: Update

Health Canada is advising about unauthorized sexual enhancement products that may pose serious health risks. The products are labelled to contain or have been tested and found to contain dangerous ingredients. Health Canada updates the table below when it finds unauthorized health products for sexual enhancement.

The unauthorized products added are:

All Nite Long	Labelled to contain mucuna pruriens (12% L-dopa)	
ExtenZe	Labelled to contain yohimbe	
Ginseng Red 2000	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain sildenafil	
Horny Goat Weed	Labelled to contain mucuna pruriens seed extract (12% L-dopa)	
Magnum XXL 750K (red label)	Product with similar packaging was tested by Australia's Therapeutic Goods Administration and found to contain tadalafil	
Magnum XXL 750K (gold label)		
Poseidon Platinum 3500	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain tadalafil	
Triple Green	Labelled to contain yohimbe	
Magnum XXL 250K	Product with similar packaging was tested by Australia's Therapeutic Goods Administration and found to contain tadalafil	
Black Panther	Labelled to contain yohimbe	Hasty Market 670 Rexdale Blvd Toronto, ON
Rhino 7 Platinum 5000	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain sildenafil and yohimbe	
Spanish Fly 22,000	Product with similar packaging (previously seized) was tested and found to contain tadalafil	
White Panther	Labelled to contain yohimbe
